FROM YOUR PRO

The Pro Shop hours for April will be 8:00am until dark weekdays and weekends. The hours for May through August on weekdays will be 7:00am until 7:00pm and on weekends 6:00am until 6:00pm.

New merchandise is arriving daily, so come in, check it out and update your golf wardrobe and equipment.

The annual Mudders tournament will be on Saturday, April 24th with a 10:30 shotgun start. Following the tournament will be the Spring Frolic, with cocktails from 4:30 to 5:30 and dinner served at 5:30. Applications for the Mudders Tournament and the Spring Frolic are available in the Pro Shop now.

Posting of scores started on April 15th and will end on Oct 31st. This is a longer than usual posting season. Don't forget if you play 9 or 18 holes you must post

your score within 24 hours. This rule is in effect for league, tournaments and casual play.

Something new this year! Some tournament entry forms will be available on our web site. Go to www.caledoniacc.com and click on the "Schedule" button at the left. The tournament for which an entry is available will be highlighted in red. Download it, print it, fill it out and drop it off in the Pro Shop.



The tee book is in the Pro Shop for the month of April. Call the Pro Shop for tee times. Remember to check in the Pro Shop before going out.

There is a new way for tournament score posting. You will be responsible for posting your own tournament scores as a "T" score for the club's plaque tournaments. For example: the Mudders is a "T" score. Stag days are not. The Ladies Invite is a "T" score. The Ladies Filly day is not. Al will post a sign for all the "T" scores. If you have any questions, see Al in the Pro Shop.

Please Note: If you pick up on a hole in a tournament or any other round played, you must use the equitable stroke system in order to mark and post a score for that hole. The equitable stroke system is posted by the computer. Need help? See Al.
